

Top Ten Benefits of Emdeon Business Services versus Legacy

- Same report format for all reports.
 - Old reports are payer specific to the switch the claim processed on.
- Government payer reports are sent back in one consolidated format allowing vendors to program to one format.
 - Old reports are payer specific on the government side and require individual parsers to be written.
- Reports are event based and generated throughout the day.
 - Old reports are batched and generated on a nightly basis.
- ASCII delimited format available to vendors.
 - Old reports do not have this capability.
- REF*D9 (submitted claim id) is returned on both medical and hospital machine readable reports.
 - Old reports (claim status overlay) only return the REF*D9 value for medical claims.
- Payer acceptance reports are returned.
 - Old reports do not return payer accepted statuses.
- One consolidated payer rejection report is returned to the submitter.
 - Old reports split out payer rejection reports into four different reports: R059, R060, R061, and R062.
- Reports are printed on standard 8 x 11 sheets of paper.
 - Old reports are 132 columns wide.
- NPI is available only on new reports.
- New reports will match Emdeon Claim Vision for Partners for more accurate tracking and backup.
